Session Four - Respect AT HOME

There's no substitute for respect within the home. Whenever the going starts to get a little rough, remember that everyone, from the youngest toddler to the most senior grandparent, has a need to be treated with respect and consideration. A short pause, a deep breath, and a determination to treat others with courtesy go a long way toward assuring smooth sailing. Doing this will refocus your thoughts toward WWJD (What Would Jesus Do?)

God said in Genesis 2:18, 21-22:

“And the Lord said, it is not good that a man should be alone. I will make him a helper comparable to him.”

God created each of us with specific roles in our relationships. Ms Becker examine these roles and how they fit together to complete His plan for the home.

There is one other admonishment that we are given in the bible about choosing relationships which has nothing to do with nationality or race as some have tried to say. It is called '**Being unequally yoked**' in 2 Corinthians 6:14.

“Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness?”

A believer should seek a relationship with a believer, not a non-believer. God has given the headship of the home to the man and the man should take the role of spiritual leader of the household. This is God's plan. For women already unequally yoked, the woman should help the man take this role instead of usurping his authority, primarily by example (showing her faith, attending church and raising children to believe in God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit.)

God created us as a family. He calls us His Children. He is the head of our lives and we should always give Him the honor He deserves, and complete the roles He has given us.
